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Gcse 9 To 1 Qualification

The reformed GCSE qualifications will be awarded on a grade scale of 9 (the highest grade) to 1 (the lowest). This new scale will be aligned to key grades on the current A* to G scale. broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 4 and above as currently achieve a grade C and above. broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 7 and above as currently achieve a grade A and above.
